Dr. David Vaziri is a board-certified orthopedic surgeon of the American Board of Orthopedic Surgeons. He has a sub-specialty board certification in Sports Medicine. His practice focuses on general orthopedics, sports medicine and regenerative medicine.

He developed an interest in regen medicine as a result of his research in bone pathology at St. Louis University.
